Recent additions to the faculty of the college of law are Prof. Luis J. Gonzaga and Mr. Estelito Mendoza. Messrs. Gonzaga and Mendoza are both *cum laude* graduates of the UP College of Law, the former in 1940 and the latter in 1952. Mr. Mendoza also holds a master of laws degree from Harvard.

The debate between the University of the Philippines and the Ateneo de Manila colleges of law, originally scheduled for last November 21, has been postponed indefinitely. Ecclesiastical authorities would not allow the Ateneo debaters to take part in the debate because they drew the negative side on the proposition, "Resolved: That communism be outlawed in the Philippines."

They were given gold, silver and bronze medals respectively, in addition to cash prizes.
