CARLOS A. BARRIOS (1909-1967)

Professor Carlos A. Barrios dedicated the test years of his life to the University of the Philippines. On the law faculty from 1950 until his death, he was to hold various other positions — as Secretary of the College of Law, Director of the University Union and Placement Bureau, Assistant Head of the Division of Publications of the U.P. Law Center, rapporteur and researcher of the Administrative Code Revision Project, and Business Manager of this journal. But his enthusiasm for law teaching never flagged. Many of this happiest hours were spent among his students.

Don Caloy as his close associates called him, was a man to turn to when in trouble. His colleagues, the students and others knew this well. He was not one to mention the many kindnesses he had done. He was a man of great humility. But there are many who will remember him for his unfailing understanding and generosity. Sir Winston Churchill speaking of one such a man said, he "banked his treasures in the hearts of his friends, and they will cherish his memory till their time is come."

A good man has passed on. He will be missed.
